Vocational Education and Training

CHC50121 Diploma of Early Childhood Education & Care

- 15 units in total (13 core units and 2 elective units)
- Runs every Wednesday for approximately 5 to 6 months
- 15 units are delivered over 15 weeks plus work experience
- This course includes 280 hours of Vocational Placement (work experience) completed within a regulated childcare service, this includes your hours from Certificate III.
- TTM have arrangements with many childcare centres and assist with the Vocational Placement (VP). Many students gain employment through their VP
- Course runs on a rolling in take, so you may start the course at any time
- Includes First Aid and CPR training
- Full trainer support is available throughout your course, with online and in class options.

Are you eligible for Government Funding?

- The program is open to any Queensland resident aged 15 years or over who is no longer at school (except for VET in Schools students)
- Is an Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency.
- Prospective students must not have or be enrolled in a certificate IV level or higher qualification, not including qualifications completed at school and foundations skills training.

If you do not qualify for this government funding you may still be eligible to undertake the course through Back to Work funding (if you are unemployed or upskilling in your current role or changing careers). If no funding is available to you, payment plans are available for full fees (please call us for more details).

If you do qualify for the funding and wish to enrol please print off and complete the enrolment form attached (please note that page 4 needs to be signed by a JP), and return it to our office at your earliest convenience with 2 forms of identification (e.g. Medicare Card and Drivers Licence).

Our funded courses require a one-off student contribution fee of \$380 or \$280 for concessional or returning students.
